On May 6, 2016, at the beautiful Westin Pasadena, Project IMPACT will celebrate our 30th Year Anniversary. Our special guest speaker will be Bishop Tom Benjamin (see below).

Over the past 30 years, it has been a remarkable journey:

- Started 27 Impact programs throughout the United States,
- Rescued over 90,000 youth from neglect, abuse and violence through programs of self and community empowerment,
- Invited to the White House three times and congratulated by the President of the United States.
- Had legislation written for program expansion in Indiana and Georgia,
- Received National, State and Local Awards and recognitions from the US Senate, the US Congress, from the US Department of Education and the US Department of Health and Human Services; received State Senate and Assembly recognitions in California, Indiana, Georgia and Ohio; received numerous awards from County, City and Local School Districts,
- Became a Unit of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) Pacific Southwest Region with the goal of expanding the Church's capacity to reach youth and families threatened by violence.


