Program Expansion



Youth Camp

Project IMPACT's Youth Camp provides a safe, supportive environment where young people build leadership skills, resilience, and confidence through mentorship, enrichment activities, and positive peer engagement.

Project Fatherhood

Project Fatherhood empowers fathers and father figures with parenting education, life skills, and support systems that strengthen families and promote positive outcomes for children.

School-Based and Peer Support Programs

Our School-Based and Peer Support Program offers students on-campus mentoring, counseling, and peer-led support to promote academic success, social-emotional wellness, and positive decision-making.

Mental Health Services

Project IMPACT's Mental Health Services provide culturally responsive, trauma-informed counseling, case management, crisis intervention, and rehabilitation services for youth and families from birth through age 26 who are navigating emotional, behavioral, and mental health challenges. Currently we provide mental health services in 15 schools.

Family Preservation Program

The Family Preservation Program delivers intensive, in-home support and counseling to at-risk families to help children remain safely in their homes while strengthening parenting skills, family stability, and healthy relationships.

Faith-Based Partnerships

Project IMPACT collaborates with churches and faith-based organizations to strengthen families and communities by combining trusted spiritual networks with evidence-based services, mentoring, and outreach that promote hope, healing, and positive youth development.

New Programs (under development)

Commercially Sexually Exploited Children (CSEC)



The CSEC Program will provide trauma-informed services, advocacy, and wraparound support to help sexually exploited youth heal, regain stability, and move toward safe, self-sufficient futures. Los Angeles County ranks among the top CSEC population in the nation.

Low-Income Housing (25% Set Aside for the Unhoused)

This initiative will expand access to affordable housing while reserving 25% of units for individuals experiencing homelessness, creating stable pathways to housing, supportive services, and long-term independence. Homelessness, along with the need to provide low-income housing, remains one of the top priorities in Los Angeles County.
